

Family Group Homes run by Glastonbury, Victoria

1970s – 2000s

Details

From the mid 1970s Glastonbury – Geelong Protestant Orphanage, and its successors Glastonbury Children's Home and Glastonbury Child and Family Services, ran a number of family group homes in the Geelong area. The first family group home was established by Glastonbury in 1974. Over the following decade Glastonbury opened several more family group homes in the Geelong area. The exact opening and closing dates for many of these homes are not yet known.
