Details

Stewart Cottage Family Group Home, in Toombul, was operated by the Methodist and Uniting Churches. It officially opened 13 October 1962. Management was transferred to the newly-created Uniting Church 22 June 1977. According to the publication, *Missing Pieces* (2001), it transitioned from a Family Group Home to a Receiving, Assessment, Placement and Therapy residential around 1989. Stewart Cottage Family Group Home closed in 1993.

Stewart Cottage officially opened 13 October 1962 and was licensed under *The State Children Act 1911* in 1962, and *The Children's Services Act 1965* on 4 August 1966.

Stewart Cottage Family Group Home closed after continual neighbourhood complaints. The Uniting Church also decided that security in the old building was not at a satisfactory standard for a residential facility. The residents were moved to Kingsbury.
