

Sandeman Nursery

1897 - 1898

Details

The Sandeman Nursery at Wynnum operated in conjunction with St Mary's Home. It opened in 1897 and was run by the Anglican Society of the Sacred Advent. It accommodated babies born to women at St Mary's, who were awaiting adoption or transfer to the Good Shepherd Home at Nundah. Sandeman Nursery closed in 1898 and the children were transferred to St Mary's at Taringa.

 Babies accommodated at Sandeman Nursery who were not adopted out were transferred to the Home of the Good Shepherd, Nundah.

 Babies born at St Mary's Home were sent to Sandeman Nursery while awaiting adoption.
- St Mary's Home (1898 1919)
 When the Sandeman Nursery closed, babies in the home were transferred to St Mary's Home at Taringa.
