

Aboriginal Affairs Board, South Australian Government

1963 – 1971

Details

The Aboriginal Affairs Board was formed in 1963 as a result of the Aboriginal Affairs Act 1962. It replaced the Aborigines Protection Board. After the passing of the Aboriginal Affairs Act Amendment Act 1968 the Aboriginal Affairs Board's role became a purely advisory one. With the passing of the Community Welfare Act 1972 the Aboriginal Affairs Act 1962 -1968 was repealed. The Aboriginal Affairs Board submitted their last Annual Report in 1971.
