

Cerebral Palsy Tasmania

Details

Cerebral Palsy Tasmania replaced the Cerebral Palsy Association of Tasmania in December 2000. Its purpose was to provide support and assistance to people who were affected by cerebral palsy. In 2013, Cerebral Palsy Tasmania merged with UnitingCare Tasmania but retained its own name. It appears that when UnitingCare Tasmania became Uniting Victoria & Tasmania in 2017, the Cerebral Palsy Tasmania name was no longer used for the program, however services for people with Cerebral Palsy continued to be offered by Uniting Victoria & Tasmania.
