Details

The Native Welfare Act Amendment Act 1960 amended the Native Welfare Act 1954, so that people in Western Australia defined as a 'quadroon' or 'less than quadroon blood' were no longer to be considered 'natives'. The Native Welfare Act Amendment Act 1960 was repealed by the Native Welfare Act 1963.

The *Native Welfare Act Amendment Act 1960* also exempted the Minister, Commissioner, Deputy Commissioner or officer of the Department of Native Welfare from personal liability in carrying out their duties under the Act.
