

Country High School Hostels Ex-Gratia Scheme, Western Australia

Details

The Country High School Hostels Ex-Gratia Scheme was established in 2012, following the Special Inquiry into St Andrew's Hostel, the Government of Western Australia established the 'Country High School Hostels Ex Gratia Scheme', administered by the Department for Communities:

This Scheme has been established to provide ex gratia payments to eligible applicants who were subjected to abuse as a boarder of a hostel operating under the auspices of the Country High School Hostels Authority during the period 1960-2006.

The scheme ended in December 2013.

- Moora (St James Hostel, Moora Residential College)
- Narrogin (Caloola House, Ellimata House, Narrogin High School Hostel, Narrogin Residential College)
- Northam (Adamson House, Northam Residential College, St Christopher's Hostel)

• Merredin Residential College (1954 - current)

People who were at St Michael's or Merredin Residential College as students were eligible to apply for the Country High School Hostels Ex Gratia Scheme.

• Narrogin Residential College (1963 - current)

People who were at Narrogin Hostel as students were eligible to apply for the Country High School Hostels Ex Gratia Scheme.

• St Christopher's Hostel, Northam (1941 - 2002)

People who were at St Christopher's as students were eligible to apply for the Country High School Hostels Ex Gratia Scheme.

• St James Residential College, Moora (c. 1977 - current)

People who were at St James Hostel (Moora Residential College) as students were eligible to apply for the Country High School Hostels Ex Gratia Scheme.

• The Priory Hostel, Albany (1955? - 1988?)

People who lived at The Priory Hostel while going to high school in Albany were eligible to apply for the Country High School Hostels Ex Gratia Scheme.

• Craig House (1949 - 1978)

People who were at Craig House as students were eligible to apply for the Country High School Hostels Ex Gratia Scheme.

• Carnarvon High School Hostel (1964 - 1980s)

People who were at the Carnarvon Hostel as students were eligible to apply for the Country High School Hostels Ex Gratia Scheme.

• Dellahale House (1964 - 2001)

People who were at Dellahale House as students were eligible to apply for the Country High School Hostels Ex Gratia Scheme.

• John Frewer House (1968 - 2001)

People who were at John Frewer House as students were eligible to apply for the Country High School Hostels Ex Gratia Scheme.

- Hardie House, South Hedland (1964? 1990?)
- St Andrew's Hostel, Esperance (1968 2000?)

People who were at St Andrew's Hostel, Esperance as students were eligible to apply for the Country High School Hostels Ex Gratia Scheme.
