Case Study 19: Bethcar Children's Home was a public hearing of the Royal Commission into Institutional Responses to Child Sexual Abuse, held in Sydney from October to December 2014. It inquired into the experiences of former child residents at Bethcar Children's Home, Brewarrina, New South Wales. During the hearings evidence was heard from former residents of Bethcar Children's Home, as well as representatives from the police, government, and legal representatives.

In November 2015, the Royal Commission subsequently published its findings in the *Report of Case Study No.* 19: The response of the State of New South Wales to child sexual abuse at Bethcar Children's Home in Brewarrina, New South Wales.
