Details

The Department of Seniors, Disability Services and Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Partnerships was established in late 2020. It amalgamated the recently abolished Department of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Partnerships with the Seniors and Disability Services functions of the former Department of Communities, Disability Services and Seniors.

In May 2023, the Department of Seniors, Disability Services and Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Partnerships was renamed the Department of Treaty, Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Partnerships, Communities and the Arts.
