The Department of Youth Justice and Victim Support was created following an election in November 2024, where the Department of Youth Justice was renamed.

The Department runs youth detention centres in Queensland, and authorises the Department of Families, Seniors, Disability Services and Child Safety to provide access to youth justice records through its Right to Information department.
