



2nd Salvation Army RESCUE HOME Opened Feb. 1896 w/o fanfare!
Within 2 years it closed when the 'CORNELIE' Rescue Home opened on 28 Dec. 1897
At 79 Lincoln Street, Highgate by Lady Smith (*Wife of His Excellency the Governor*)
Today (2009) it is known as the "GRACEVILLE WOMEN'S CENTRE" (*see photos over*)...





1st Salvation Army RESCUE HOME in Western Australia
Commenced – 27 Dec. 1894 & Officially Opened 18 Feb. 1895
With Comm. Thomas Coombs, Sir George Shenton, Mr. S. Burt (Acting Premier)
Located at 192 Claisbrook Road. East Perth (Lot 11 Corner of Summer Street)
It closed 12 months later as too small & moved across the Road (See Below)
