Summary

This is a list of items in the State Records of South Australia Series *GRG18/2 Correspondence files ('ED' files) – Education Deptment (1896-1959)* that may be of relevance to people who grew up in Out-of-Home Care and members of the Stolen Generations. These include records relating to particular children's homes and institutions, Missions and Aboriginal Reserves, organisations involved in providing out-of-home care, and individual children. Most identified files relate to either Point McLeay Mission School, or the Salvation Army Probationary School Mount Barker (Eden Park). These items have been identified by title only. There may be other items of relevance in *GRG18/2 Correspondence files ('ED' files) – Education Deptment (1896-1959)* that are also of relevance that have not been listed here, including files that include the names of individual children or schools attended by children in out-of-home care.
